Call to Order: Kevin Gourlay called the meeting to order at 7:05pm

# 1. Land Acknowledgement

## 2. Season Summary:

- Kevin Gourlay provided a summary of the successful 2023 season, including:
  - 160 Coaches/Managers and over 250 volunteers
  - First annual Bat-A-Thon
  - Minors Assessments & Play-offs implemented, improving parity among teams
  - District wide Girls at Bat program launched, supporting girls in baseball
    - UBC has offered to run the all-girl practices through their coaching next year. This will require a volunteer coordinator from the league.
  - Major concession stand improvements
    - Someone with FoodSafe certification is required on site whenever the concession is open. This has been a challenge.
  - All-Star & Select Teams: Jericho Baseball teams in every division (age 7-12)
    - Hosted District 1 11-12 All-star Tournament, and the 10 finals
    - JB 8 selects were Candy Cup Champions

- 10 All-stars District 1 Champions, came in 3rd at BC Provincials.
- Appreciation to Tanja Reinkens, who makes everything run as the league's only employee.

#### 3. Registrar's Report

- Kevin reported that 468 children were registered in the 2023 season
- Registration is down from 2022, particularly in the Minors age groups
- Families are encouraged to reach out and invite friends to register in 2024.

### 4. Financial Summary

- Kevin reported that the Society has a stronger financial position than in 2022.
  - Cash balance of ~\$67K does not reflect 12K in pending transactions.
  - Appreciation for Jennifer Jones who led a successful application for \$25,000.67 in BC Gaming Grant funding.
- A balanced budget is projected for 2024
  - Capital projects for the next fiscal year may include expanding the Cararvon batting cage, potentially into a year-round facility

# 5. Sponsorship and Bat-a-Thon

- Casey Weeks reported that the first annual Bat-a-Thon netted \$10,000
  - Appreciation for David Duizer for coordination and awareness raising.
  - Considering a more carnival atmosphere for the Bat-a-Thon in 2024
- Several teams were sponsored this season, raising \$12,000, with potential to expand next year. Most sponsorship comes from engaging families.

# 6. Umpire/Rule Update

- Kevin noted the ongoing challenge to train and secure enough umpires for all games
- Appreciation for Marbrey Nienaber-Stephen, awarded Umpire of the Year
- Update on Little League Rule for Tournament Team coach training.

- Kevin encouraged all parents to come forward for roles, especially parents of younger children who can offer some continuity in the years ahead.
  - Tanja explained the ability to customise roles to maximise opportunities for all volunteers.

#### 8. Discussion and Questions

- Kevin opened the floor for general discussion and suggestions
  - Suggestion to update the website with photos including teams that win divisions, winners of player awards, etc.
  - Opportunities to maximise use of the Carnarvon and Trimble batting cages, including for revenue generation
  - Appreciation for the fall skill sessions (and for the volunteer parents who make them possible)
  - Observation that knowing schedules earlier in the season would support higher minor registration
    - Tanja sets the schedule for the younger ages, combining field availability, coach availability, and determining number of teams.

- Division Coordinators arrange older ages.
- A coach availability form was introduced last year to speed the process
